Categories

Division I

Division II

Division III – open to entries in the 2nd Leg, subject, to at least, a 16-Draw size.

Division I Player eligibility – This Division is open to any and all players.

Division II Player eligibility – This Division is open to both male and female players who are considered by the Technical Committee as “B” Players, except those players who have finished 1st or 2nd place in, at least, two legs in Division II of the 2009 Open Tournament and previous Open tournaments.

Division III Player eligibility – This Division is open ONLY to ladies (except National Training Pool players) and beginner/novice players.

Scoring System and Format

1. 11 points -PAR (Point- A- Rally)
2. Best of 5 Games (Subject to change)
3. Circuit Format for all draws and Legs

Entry Fees (Per Leg) to cover Squash court fees and markers

Format of SRAP-MILO Open

1. The SRAP-Milo 1st - 4th Legs will be Open Draws. Draw sizes are subject to the number of entries.
2. The Grand Finals for each Division will be a Draw of 16 with a losers' bracket playing for Plate. SRAP, however, reserves the right to cancel the Grand Finals for Division III.
3. The Grand Finals will be played by the overall top 16 players of each Division, based on the total points earned from the first 4 legs.
4. Players who finish 17th position and onwards after the 4th Leg will be placed in the reserves list to replace any player unable to compete in the Grand Finals.
5. Each player who joins any of the first 4 legs shall earn Qualifying Points ("QP") for the Grand Finals depending on his/her finish in each of the Leg he/she participates.
6. Qualifying Points per Leg earned for 1st – 4th Leg are as follows:

Champion	10 pts
Runner-Up	9 pts
3 rd Finish	6 pts
4 th Finish	5 pts
QF Finish	4 pts
Elim Round	2 pts

Thus, a player who finishes first in all four legs shall have a total of 40 QP. A player who goes only up to the elimination round in all four legs gets a total of 8 QP.

7. Players who withdraw after the withdrawal date must give valid reasons. SRAP's Technical Committee will decide the validity for the reason of the withdrawal. Invalid reasons will deem the player ineligible to compete in the remaining legs of the circuit.

RANKING AND SEEDING

1. Ranking is based on the ranking system with the results of the previous legs.
2. Players will then be seeded and grouped by the Technical Committee using the Random Draw Method. The draw grouping is done as stated below:
3. 16 DRAWS: 1, 2, 3/4, 5/8, 9/12 and 13/16
4. 32 DRAWS: 1, 2, 3/4, 5/8, 9/12, 13/16 and 17/32
5. Please note that players who skip or miss previous legs may be ranked lower.
6. For the Grand Finals, SRAP shall calculate the total QP of each player from all 4 legs and only the Top 16 players with the highest points will be eligible for the Grand Finals. Ties for the 16th place will be broken by a preliminary round.

Withdrawals

1. The withdrawal closing date is 5 days before the Leg
2. Withdrawals from the Leg must notify Tournament Coordinator as soon as possible by email or fax
3. Entry fees will not be refunded for withdrawals
